1. Registration is \$140 until 9:00 PM tonight then goes to \$160; Registration \$200 after 9:00 pm on 8/12/19
2. Kelly Kuhns – is the New First Aid Coordinator; Safety meeting was conducted on 6/7/19 with music directors and marching band staff w/WSSD to discuss the need for AED training (Mary Davies offered to provide information about AED training for the staff.)
3. Jen Floor – WSSD nurse will be working during Band Camp in the First Aid Tent during the day
4. Dinkles – can be purchased or rented (if not enough are available to rent – we will not be purchasing more) Purchase and rental price \$40, credited return is \$35 if returned at end of marching season with uniform turn-in. Failure to turn in at end of season results in loss of full rental cost.
5. Show shirts – looking at getting orders in early since design is already done.
6. Military Re-utilization – Depositing Center – directors are looking at instruments that are available; Boosters can also will review the list to see what would be beneficial to the program however the responsibility falls to the directors since they are the representatives of the school district.
7. Hershey Park Volunteering Fundraiser – have to be 18 or older and we earn \$6/hr (3 hours/4 Hours/5 hours shifts) and volunteers earn a free Hershey Park Day Pass.
8. Ice Cream Social – (instead of a family picnic this year) Free Ice Cream for the kids and reduced costs ice cream for the parents. The ice cream social allows for the Booster Board Members to socialize and answer questions for parents that are attending. This will be Saturday, September
9. OPT OUT AMOUNT – was brought up as a discussion point for fundraising
10. SOLICIT SPONSORSHIP from COMPANIES – for example to sponsor X number of students for their registration fees; or instruments
11. District Instruments – discussion point - should a rental fee be charged to maintain, replace instruments?
12. Spirit Wear – Continue to use Twisted Sportswear powered by Hot Frog; some participants would like winter coats and vest options; also looking for new vendors to use
13. Stadium Seating covers are being remade
14. The Budget was purposed for the 2019-2020 school year and accepted.
