Dear West Shore Marching Band parents,

Recently there has been some discussion about placing videos of our marching show from football or competition performances on Youtube or Facebook. It seems only natural to want to do this considering it is a source of pride and we like sharing these moments with family and friends. There is an issue however that many of us have not been made aware of, including myself. Apparently there are groups who use Youtube and social media like Facebook to steal ideas from other competitive groups. I know this may sound a bit absurd and over the top, but it is happening. While it is not our style to worry about what other programs are doing, it is certainly probable that other groups do use this as a means to get a competitive edge so to speak. With that said, if you choose to video our show, I would ask that you simply use a password or other means of limiting your viewership. I believe this to be a perfect compromise to both sides of the discussion.
