2. Poinsettia fundraiser - planning now for plant availability and distribution for the winter concerts
3. West Shore Marching Band Home Show - October 2nd. A meeting specifically addressing the events for that day will be held on September 23rd. Patron ads are needed for the program and must be turned in to Ben Rupp by September 13th.

6. Treasurer's Report - Budget has not yet been set up by the Executive Committee. A Reconciliation Summary (Checking, Period ending 8/31/2021) and a Profits & Loss Budget vs. Actual (June through August 2021) was provided.
